The Oroville Winter Emergency Camp provides temporary housing for a fee of \$7 to those who have no housing during the winter months.

A bed, plastic covered mattress, locker (lock is not provided), and refrigerator are provided in the sleeping trailers. The Camp does not provide meals. OHA reserves the right to assign persons to a specific sleeping trailer. The doors to the trailers are open 24/7.

Person staying at the Camp are responsible for keeping their personal space clean and neat. They will also be assigned chores, such as cleaning the shower, toilets, and kitchen areas, and picking up the grounds.

Sleeping bags, towels, toiletries are available for those who need them.

Pets including service animals are not allowed on site. No Paws Left Behind will take pets at no charge on a space available basis. No Paws Left Behind is located 2 miles south of Oroville. Call for directions (509) 476-2991. Hours are Wednesday thru Sunday 10am to 4pm.
